

School classes at the Kunstmuseum Luzern

Dear Visitors

Welcome to the Kunstmuseum Luzern!

So that your visit runs as smoothly as possible we would like to draw your attention to the following points:

Important

- School classes must be accompanied by at least one teacher.
- That teacher assumes responsibility for the whole class.
- Teachers are asked to remain with their class at all times and keep them together.
- Please ensure that all the pupils stay at a distance of at least one meter away from the art works and do not lean against walls or display cases.
- Attention! Sometimes there are works of art unprotected on the floor.
- In case of any damage done, you, as the teacher are the museum's contact person and are requested to give the necessary information on how the damage occurred.

Other points

- Please use the cloakroom storage boxes for school classes in front of the lockers.
- Please have consideration for other people and groups in the museum. Avoid making noise and keep the passageways clear.
- Writing and drawing may only be done in pencil.
- It is not permitted to eat and drink in the museum.
- It is not permitted to run around in the museum.
- The folding chairs are not intended for use by school classes.

In the collection presentation in the first room you will find handouts for children with interesting tasks. We would be delighted if you and your class made use of them. We wish you an interesting visit!
